The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act as of July 8, 2020 is \$23,800.

The estimated total number of students at the institution who are or could be eligible to participate in the Federal student financial aid programs under Section 484 of the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended, and thus are eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act is 204.

The total number of students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act is 119.

To determine which students received Emergency Financial Aid Grants for Spring 2020 expenses, Emperor's College asked eligible students to complete an application for COVID-19 emergency assistance.

Emperor's College sent multiple emails to students to share the information about the availability of the grants for Spring 2020 expenses. In addition, Emperor's College posted the grant application on its website.

As of September 1, 2020, the College disbursed \$41,148 of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) funds equally among 127 students who completed a grant application, submitted a FASFA, and were eligible to receive the emergency grant. Each student received a total of \$324.
